

Hide a Bear

Take your cup and have your partner cover his/her eyes. Hide some bears under the cup and show some. Have your partner look and tell them how many altogether. He/she has to say how many are under the cup.

Fishing for Tens

- Remove the tens from the deck before beginning this game. Each player takes 5 cards to start. When it is your turn, you ask your partner for one card. If the partner does not have it, you take one from the deck. Then you lay down all the pairs in your hand that total ten. At the end of your turn, pick up the number of cards you need to have five in your hand before your partner's turn.

Concentration

- First select the target amount. For example 7. Then remove the cards from the decks that are more than or the same as seven. Mix up the cards and lay them in rows of 6 on the table. Players take turn turning over two cards, trying to make a seven. If they are able to do so they pick up those two cards and choose again. Otherwise, they turn the card back over face down and the next player takes a turn.
